
Whilst excellent teaching and learning is at the core of all we do, we place a strong emphasis on good relationships and promote independence, equality, resilience and consideration for others throughout the entire student body.

Our support networks include pastoral leaders, a student support team, a specialist careers lead, and a dedicated counsellor who runs a range of wellbeing and additional support programmes for our young people.

Our house system allows students across year groups to mix, socialise and get to know one another — often enabling older students to mentor and support younger pupils, and promotes healthy competition and reward between houses in a structured environment. Students also learn together through daily tutoring sessions within their year group and can aspire to become prefects, house captains, peer mentors and head boy or girl.

At East Leake Academy, we produce well-rounded and well-educated individuals who are prepared for the world beyond.







Curriculum

We offer a wide-ranging curriculum designed to challenge and stretch students.

All subjects have a rigorous five-year scheme of learning that aims to develop every individual learner's skills and knowledge, so that students have the ability to secure excellent Level 2 qualifications (GCSE or equivalent).

We aim to help every student reach their full potential regardless of their starting point. The curriculum is also designed to prepare students with the skills and knowledge they will need to have a successful transition onto Level 3 qualifications (A Level or equivalent) during post 16 studies.

We passionately believe in students following their interests and studying a broad and balanced curriculum that is right for them as an individual. Particular focus has been placed over the years on the importance of STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) subjects. We also believe equally in the power of the creative subjects including arts, humanities, languages and physical education in helping to develop well-rounded, well-informed and confident learners.

Robust monitoring systems provide regular assessment and progress to parents via reports, updates and parents' evenings.

Facilitating learning

Our modern, purpose-built academy offers the space to learn for all year groups.

We have fully equipped science labs, design and technology rooms, art rooms, food science facilities and IT suites. Green outdoor spaces provide the perfect backdrop for sports, complemented by two indoor sports halls and an adjoining community leisure centre and pool on site.

Sixth formers enjoy an independent learning space in their own Sixth Form Centre, complete with a café, social and breakout spaces, and IT labs.

Opportunities abound

Our academy experience is enhanced by a broad range of extra-curricular opportunities aimed to help our students flourish as confident, well-rounded individuals.

In addition to clubs covering dance, drama, music, art, chess and sports, students have the opportunity to achieve in many other ways.

Our enrichment programme includes activities to enhance essential lifeskills. such as the Duke of Edinburgh's Award, and to support entrepreneurial skills, including the Young Enterprise Network.

Students have an abundance of opportunities through educational trips, careers fairs and university visits, as well as hearing from visiting speakers to the academy.

Our overseas links help students broaden their horizons in an increasingly global world. We have run a German exchange programme for the past 40 years, as well as offering an annual ski trip to Italy. Other residential visits to Europe help our students develop cultural understanding and awareness.

Responsible individuals

Our students are encouraged to support charitable initiatives both in the UK and overseas. These help us to prepare our students to be thoughtful and responsible citizens of the future.

Our students have visited Ghana on three separate occasions as part of an expedition to help build an orphanage and kindergarten. As well as learning the value of helping others, students take responsibility by fundraising to raise money for their travel costs, and gain teamwork, leadership and organisational abilities by working together to achieve a common goal.
