Developing their knowledge of the key literary traditions and stylistic devices used by writers, supports our students' analytical reading skills and writing ability.


Year 7: Great Expectations, Animal Farm and Shakespeare's Villains

Year 9: The Tempest, Of Mice and Men/To Kill a Mockingbird and Short Stories


