








KS3 Languages



All students at ELA study either French or German at KS3. We begin by focussing on phonics to develop communication skills and discuss word origins and formation.

We move on to embed speaking, reading, listening and writing across a range of topics such as hobbies, where you live, preparing food and going on holiday.




KS4 Languages



Students can opt to take the language they have studied during KS3 for GCSE. KS3 languages covers core content to fully prepare students for taking a language at GCSE.

We follow AQA GCSE French and German, which comprises of speaking, reading, listening and writing components worth 25% each. The broad themes we cover are identity and culture, local and international areas of interest, current and future study and employment.





Homework

Homework is set of vocabulary once a week at KS3 and supports memory recall of key vocabulary. All KS3 students complete weekly mini quizzes in class, which supports students to form their own language within the topic they are studying.


