- Duration of exams 2h 30 mins each





### What skills will be assessed?

- Assessment objectives:
- AO1: demonstrate, organise and communicate knowledge and understanding, making supported judgements and exploring concepts.
- AO2: Analyse and evaluate primary source material.
- AO3: Analyse and evaluate interpretations.



### Breadth study: Tsarist and Communist Russia 1855-1964

- This unit explores more than a century of Russian history which witnessed dramatic changes.
- Year 12: Tsarist Russia up to the Bolshevik Revolution in 1917
- Year 13: Communist Russia including Lenin, Stalin and Khrushchev, up to 1964
- You will be assessed on AO1 and AO3 in the exam.



### Depth study: The Making of Modern Britain 1951-2007

- This unit explores the development of Britain from the Second World War to the present day and shows the many changes which have taken place in British politics, society and position in the world.
- Year 12: Building a new Britain 1951-1979
- Year 13: Modern Britain 1979-2007
- You will be assessed on AO1 and AO2 in the exam.

- Students to independently research and write a detailed essay.
- Excellent preparation for the demands of university education.
- Worth 20% of A level grade and you will be assessed on AO1, AO2 and AO3.
