The Diverse Academies Trust [safeguarding](#) policy on sets out the trust's approach to allowing providers into the academy as visitors to talk to our students.

East Leake Academy will provide an appropriate room or assembly hall to be agreed. All rooms will have projectors and screens provided. Computer rooms can also be arranged. The Careers Leader will organise this, working closely with the provider to ensure the facilities are appropriate to the audience. Appropriate safeguarding checks will be carried out. Providers will be met and supervised by a member of the Careers Team who will facilitate.

The academy will consider live online encounters with providers where requested, and these may be broadcast into classrooms or the school assembly hall. Technology checks in advance will be required to ensure compatibility of systems.

Parental/carer involvement is encouraged, and parents/carer may be invited to attend the events to meet the providers.
