Curriculum

Academic achievement is at the heart of all that we do here at East Leake Academy. We offer a vibrant and stimulating learning environment where students can aim high to achieve their full potential.

We offer a wide ranging curriculum designed to challenge and stretch students. All subjects have a rigorous five-year scheme of learning that aims to develop every individual learner's skills and knowledge, so that students have the ability to secure excellent Level 2 qualifications (GCSE or equivalent). We aim to help every student reach their full potential regardless of their starting point. The curriculum is also designed to prepare students with the skills and knowledge they will need to have a successful transition onto Level 3 qualifications (A Level or equivalent) during post 16 studies.

We passionately believe in students following their interests and studying a broad and balanced curriculum that is right for them as an individual. Particular focus has been placed over the years on the importance of STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) subjects. We also believe equally in the power of creative subjects including arts, humanities, languages and physical education in helping develop well-rounded, well-informed and confident learners.

Robust monitoring systems provide regular assessment and progress to parents via reports, updates and parents' evenings.



Facilitating learning

Our modern, purpose-built academy offers the space to learn for all year groups. We have fully equipped science labs, design and technology rooms, art rooms, food science facilities and IT suites. Green outdoor spaces provide the perfect backdrop for sports, complemented by two indoor sports halls and an adjoining community leisure centre and pool on site.

Sixth Form

We have a dedicated sixth form centre at the academy. The high expectations and inclusive ethos at years 7-11 is embraced in post 16 study, whilst encouraging independence. We have a hugely talented team of teachers relentlessly monitoring the high quality of lessons, as well as a caring pastoral team who help students make those all-important decisions about the future.

Enrichment and personal development

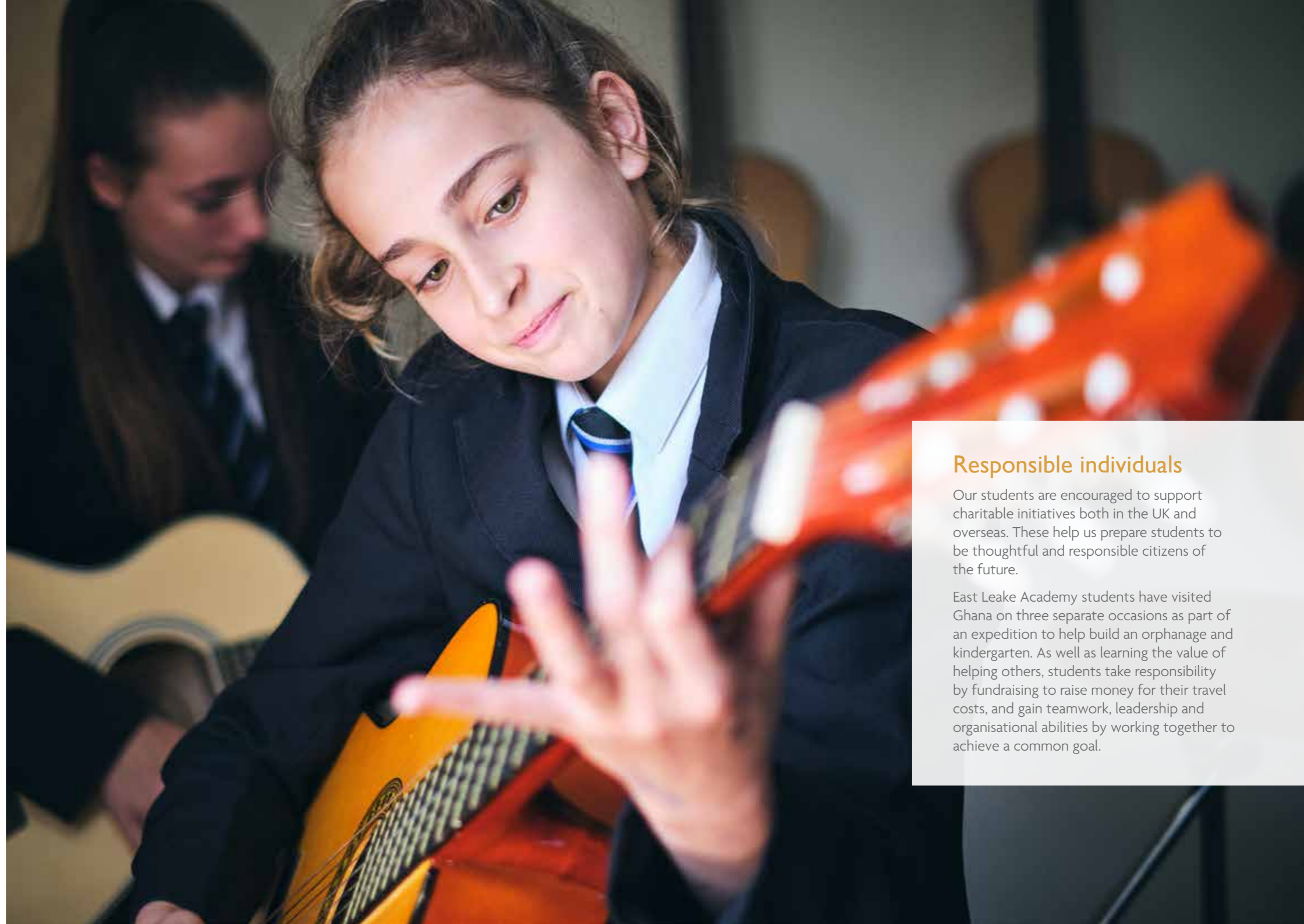
The academy experience is enhanced by a broad range of extracurricular opportunities aimed to help our students flourish as confident, well-rounded individuals.

In addition to lunch and after school clubs covering dance, drama, music, art and sports, students have the opportunity to achieve in many other ways and can take advantage of further personal development opportunities delivered during drop-down sessions.

Our enrichment programme includes activities to enhance essential life skills, such as the Duke of Edinburgh's Award, and to support entrepreneurial skills by participation in the Young Enterprise Network.

Students have an abundance of opportunities through educational trips, careers fairs and university visits, as well as hearing from visiting speakers to the academy.

Our overseas links help students broaden their horizons in an increasingly global world. We have maintained strong links with a German school for over twenty years engaging in exchange visits, as well as offering regular residential trips to Europe and beyond helping our students develop cultural understanding and awareness.



Responsible individuals

Our students are encouraged to support charitable initiatives both in the UK and overseas. These help us prepare students to be thoughtful and responsible citizens of the future.

East Leake Academy students have visited Ghana on three separate occasions as part of an expedition to help build an orphanage and kindergarten. As well as learning the value of helping others, students take responsibility by fundraising to raise money for their travel costs, and gain teamwork, leadership and organisational abilities by working together to achieve a common goal.

Support and guidance

Pastoral care

At the academy, we embrace a horizontal tutoring system. Each day, students join their tutor group for a 20-minute session that provides a range of activities designed to support their own personal development. A horizontal system enables a bespoke pastoral programme to be followed that meets the needs of the year group and allows students to form positive relationships with their peers.

Our support networks include pastoral leaders for each year group, a student support team, a careers advisor and a dedicated counsellor who runs a range of wellbeing and additional specialist support programmes for our young people.

Students are placed within one of our four houses when they join us and will take part in challenges, such as sports days, as part of their house.

Our houses – **Eagle**, **Harrier**, **Kestrel** and **Osprey**.



Student leadership

We offer a number of opportunities for students to take part in leadership roles, such as head girl and boy, house captains and vice-captains, peer mentors, sports ambassadors, eco and community ambassadors, and enterprise ambassadors.

Careers

We are proactive in ensuring all students engage with a comprehensive programme of careers education, information, advice and guidance (CEIAG). We have a dedicated careers leader who supports students with individual and impartial advice and guidance. Our careers programme starts right from year 7 and continues into sixth form.

SEND

The academy offers robust support for students with special educational needs, focused on communication and interaction, cognition and learning, behaviour, and emotions and social development. Our staff also work with outside agencies for additional specialist advice and provision. Our inclusive ethos aims to encourage all students to be actively involved in their own learning. This involves valuing all students and staff equally, reducing barriers to learning and providing appropriate support so that all students feel able to participate.

The application process for year 7 normally opens in August each year, closing in late October, with offers made to families in the following March.
