Dear Parent/ Carer,

Thank you for choosing East Leake Academy as the preferred school for your child. Please find below details about the upcoming transfer days on **Monday 3rd July, Tuesday 4th July and Wednesday 5th July 2023** (students are invited to attend all three days).

- Students will be expected to make their way to the Academy for approximately 8.20am. Parents and carers are invited into the main hall until 8.30am if you wish to drop off your child and meet a small number of staff who are supporting transition days;
- Students do not need to wear their school uniform. They can wear appropriate clothing, allowing them to participate in PE lessons;
- Students will be expected to bring a bag and pencil case;
- Students may bring a packed lunch or they are more than welcome to eat in our canteen. We suggest students bring £4.00 if they wish to purchase a snack and lunch and we recommend bringing a bottle of water.

I would also like to invite you to our New Parents' Evening on **Wednesday 5th July, 6-7pm.** I do hope that you will be able to attend accompanied by your son or daughter.

The evening will be held in the school hall and commence with an introduction by Mr Reid, the Senior Leadership Team and the transition team. This will be followed by a short presentation from the Year 7 Pastoral Lead from 6.30pm.

There will be a chance to meet Pastoral Leads, Senior Leadership Team and the SENCo. At this time please have to hand your child's completed data collection sheet (they will bring a blank data collection form home with them on Monday 3rd July).
