



Year 6 transition 2024

timeline for parents

22 May – 12 June: primary school visits

Our transition leads will visit students in schools and talk to them about their journey to East Leake Academy. This is a great opportunity for students to hear about the school and ask any questions they may have about transition days. Students will also receive their transition workbook which includes both pastoral and academic tasks for them to complete.

12 June: visits to the academy

Students who are joining East Leake Academy from schools out of area are welcomed to the academy to meet the transition lead, receive their transition workbook, and ask any questions they may have.

13 June: enhanced transition visit for students with SEND

A small number of students who have been identified by primary schools as those who would benefit from an additional visit prior to transition days, will spend the morning at East Leake Academy. Students will participate in activities, meet key staff, and familiarise themselves with the building.

17 June – 21 June: postcards

Students will receive a welcome post card informing them of their house and tutor group.

26 June: welcome evening & uniform pop-up shop

Parents and carers are invited into the academy for a welcome event running from **6-7pm**. There will be a presentation and talk from key staff who will share information about the transition process.

A uniform pop-up shop will also be available at the academy on this day from **3-7pm**.

1 July – 3 July: transition days

Over the course of the three days, students will spend time in their tutor group, familiarise themselves with the academy, experience a range of lessons, meet key staff, participate in house competitions, teambuilding tasks and meet friends in their new year group.
