



Dear Parent or Carer,

I would like to make you aware of the financial support available with instrument lessons at East Leake Academy. At ELA we use Inspire for the following instruments: Violin, Viola, Cello, Saxophone, Clarinet, Flute, Trumpet and Trombone.

The Inspire Music Remission Scheme, managed by the Nottinghamshire Music Hub, provides financial support for music lessons and instrument loans for children and young people. Eligibility is based on receiving free school meals, having a specific Universal Credit take-home pay (under £935/month), or being a looked-after child. The scheme aims to make music education accessible to families facing financial hardship.

What the Scheme Offers

- **Financial Contribution:** The scheme remits a significant portion of the cost of Inspire Music lessons, with some resources stating it remits 80% of the cost for a shared lesson.
- **Free Instrument Loan:** Eligible students can receive a free loan of one musical instrument.

Who is Eligible?

The remission scheme is available for families who meet **one** of the following criteria:

- Children and young people in receipt of Free School Meals.
- Children and young people with a parent/carer receiving Universal Credit, with a monthly take-home pay of less than £935.
- Looked-after children (those in the care of the local authority).
- Children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities.
